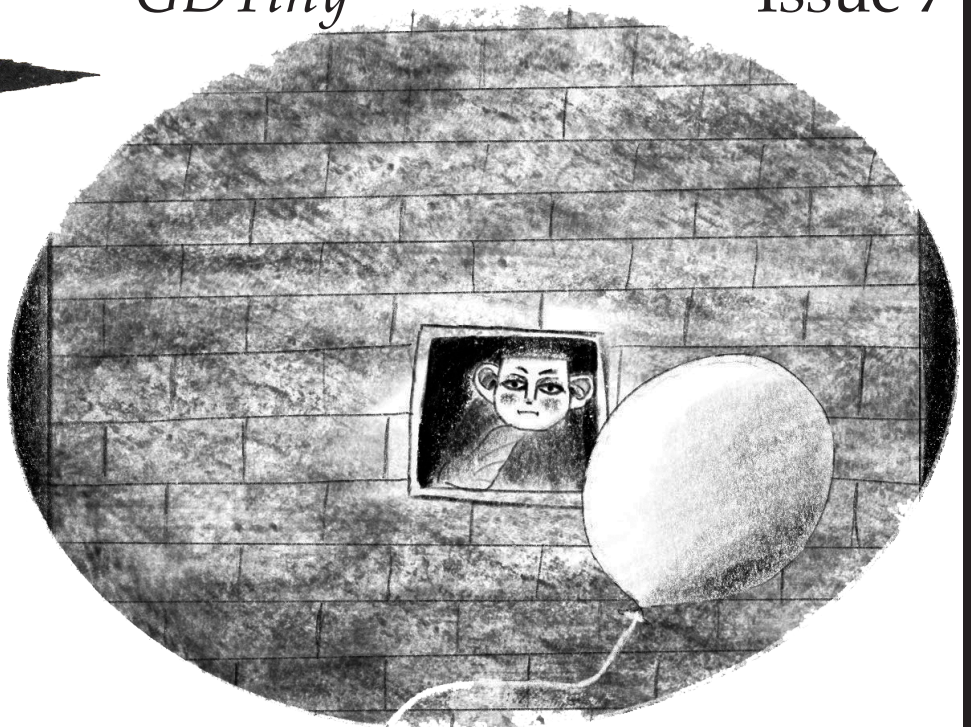

Until next week, stay safe, and be sure to frame this GDT. You'll need it when it replaces gold as the foundation of global currency. 

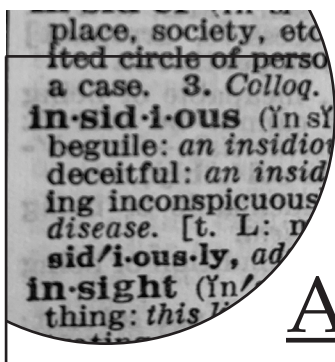
